Misc.:

- We are preparing to advertise for two positions, one new and one to fill Joe Torres' spot. Sgt. Reyes is updating our F.T.O. manual and we are reworking our hiring procedure to possibly include an entry level test and allowing those that are enrolled in an academy and about to graduate to apply.

Fire Marshal Update:

- In August Cpl. Dear delivered 70 self inspection forms.
- Reviewed plans of the new Best Western and met with LISD on fire code issues.
- Issued 2 burn permits
- Still working on plan for abandoned and dilapidated homes, still need to meet w/ Tom Cate and review new building code.

Non-Paid Officer:

- Brian Pond resigned as a non-paid officer. He had been with us since April was injured at his full-time job in early June. He left because it may be six months before he will be cleared for duty.

Animal Care and Control:

A.C.O. Bill Dixon has been staying busy with routine calls for service and planning for the new shelter. It is hard to believe how many animal control related calls we get each day. Some activity for August includes:


- Picked up 9 dogs
- Picked up 3 cats
- Set or reset 11 traps
- Responded to 5 calls for "road kill"
- Responded to 8 incidents involving wildlife (some reported in the traps)
- A total of 6 dogs and 7 cats were euthanized
- 1 cat escaped during transfer / transport.
- 1 dog escaped from the kennels.
