Animal Care and Control:


- We have moved the animals into the new shelter due to the cold weather. We are working on getting a fence installed. Some activity for November is listed below:
- Picked up 34 dogs
- Picked up 1 cat
- Set or reset 11 traps
- Responded to 8 calls for "road kill"
- Responded to 4 incidents involving wildlife
- **A total of 32 dogs euthanized**
- 1 dog died in custody.
- 1 dog escaped from the old kennels.
- Total of 141 animal related calls for service
