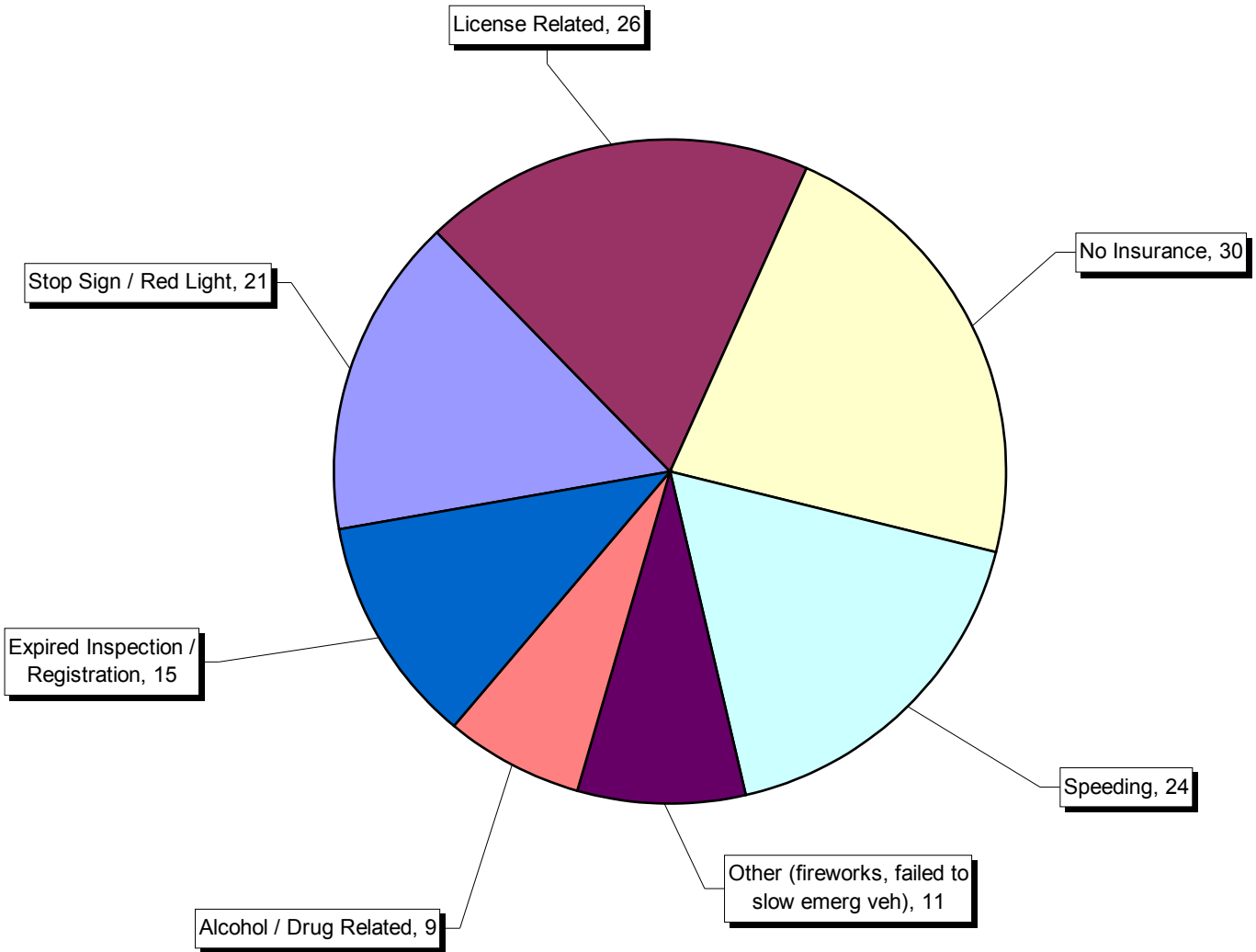
##### Recent Robberies:

## Animal Care and Control

- A fundraiser has been planned for Saturday March 6, 2010. A multi-family yard sale will be held at the Animal Control Facility. The fundraiser is being planned by the Animal Shelter Volunteers. All money raised will go toward the shelter and related programs.
- In January approx. 250 hours of volunteer service was provided by 35 shelter volunteers.
- Data from December includes:
  - 178 service call numbers assigned
  - 18 dogs picked up
  - 16 cats picked up
  - 2 dogs & 8 cats euthanized
  - 1 animal bite investigated
  - 4 wildlife calls
  - 3 deceased animals on roadway
  - 4 dogs returned to owner
  - 14 animals adopted out
