### CID Update/Major Crimes - Sgt. Reyes:


- Filed 1 Sexual Assault case with the District Attorney in Atascosa County.

## Animal Care and Control Division

- **There were 20 adoptions in August.**
  - 6 - Lytle (Inside city limits)
  - 4 - Lytle (Outside city limits)
  - 2 - Castroville
  - 4 - Natalia
  - 2 - La Coste
  - 1 - San Antonio
  - 1 - Somerset
- In August approx. **570** hours of volunteer service was provided by 34 different shelter volunteers.
- Data from August includes:
  - 292 service call numbers assigned
  - **9 dogs & 22 cats euthanized**
  - 7 wildlife calls
  - 10 deceased animals on roadway
