CID Update:

- We used our Leads on Line program to recover a 55" Flat Screen TV (Valued at \$1,500) that was taken in a burglary on Norvell St. (Nov. 10). The TV was pawned in San Antonio. This is the 2nd time the same house was burglarized. Suspects have been identified and criminal charges will be filed.

HEB Service Calls:

- In 2010 officers responded to or took reports on 208 incidents at HEB. This would include minor accidents, keys locked in a vehicle, thefts, suspicious persons, etc. This number amounts to approx. 8% of our total call volume.


