
<b>Special &amp; Significant Events / Investigations/ Activities / Misc. Information</b>

- **Fire Marshal update:** Matt and I are now both certified by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection as Basic Arson Investigators & Basic Fire Inspectors. We still need to be appointed by the City Council and get an updated fire code adopted before we will be up and running.
- **Civilian Auxiliary update:** We currently have 22 members and had a successful meeting on Feb. 19. We have a very talented and diverse group. Most members have completed the initial ride-a-long. We are in the process of developing better function descriptions and organizing the unit into smaller squads that will be easier to manage. We have already had 2 municipal court dates covered by members and 4 hours of patrol on this past Sunday morning (Special attention to recent vehicle burglaries at a couple churches).
