MISC. ITEMS

1. ROBERT CAFFEY HAS BEEN APPOINTED AS A POLICE OFFICER IN OUR NON-PAID UNIT. HE COMES TO US FROM SOMERSET P.D. WHERE HE HAS SERVED FOR THE LAST YEAR. HE CURRENTLY WORKS FOR THE STATE JAIL SYSTEM AND IS RETIRED FROM THE U.S. AIF FORCE. HE FILLS OUR SIXTH SLOT. WE ARE NOW AT FULL STAFF IN OUR NON-PAID UNIT.
2. JUNE HAS BEEN ON THE SLOW SIDE, PROPERTY CRIMES ARE WAY DOWN. ARREST AND TRAFFIC CITATIONS WERE ALSO LOWER THAN NORMAL. IN MY OPINION THIS IS A RESULT OF SCHOOL BEING OUT OF SESSION.
3. WE HAVE TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF THE "SLOWER THAN NORMAL" TIME. WE HAVE SPENT SEVERAL DAYS IN THE EVIDENCE VAULT ORGANIZING PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE. WE HAVE OBTAINED COURT DISPOSITIONS ON A LOT OF EVIDENCE AND WILL BE PREPARING TO DISPOSE OF IT PROPERLY. THIS IS MOSTLY ALCOHOL FROM D.W.I. AND RELATED CASES. WE HAVE ALSO CAUGHT UP ON CASES AND IMPROVED OUR CASE MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES.
