OTHER INFORMATION / NEWS

1. LEE PATE HAS BEEN APPOINTED AS A NON-PAID OFFICER. HIS BACKGROUND IS IN CRIME PREVENTION & FAMILY VIOLENCE. HE WILL BE ORGANIZING OUR SCHOOL PROGRAM. OUR CURRENT PLAN IS TO REACH ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES 5TH THROUGH 8TH. THIS IS WOULD BE ABOUT 450 KIDS, OUR CURRENT PLAN CONSIST OF A 50 MINUTE BLOCK OF INSTRUCTION. IT WOULD BE PRESENTED TO CLASSES OF ABOUT 20 STUDENTS EACH. OUR PLANS ARE TO START AFTER SPRING BREAK AND BE FINISHED BY THE MIDDLE OF MAY. WE HAVE MET WITH BOTH PRINCIPALS AND THEY ARE EXCITED ABOUT OUR PLANS.
2. ON THURS. MARCH 4 WE HOSTED A T.M.L. TRAINING CLASS AT THE LYTLE COMM. CENTER. IT WAS ATTENDED BY ABOUT 30 OFFICERS FROM VARIOUS AGENCIES, EIGHT OF OUR TEN OFFICERS WERE ABLE TO ATTEND. THE TOPIC WAS EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATIONS.
3. WE HAVE NUMEROUS OTHER TRAINING CLASSES THAT OFFICERS ARE ENROLLED IN. WITH LUCK THE CLASSES WILL "MAKE".
