REPORT TO MAYOR AND COUNCIL ON JUNE 14, 2004**

1. **"CLICK IT OR TICKET" PROGRAM (MAY 26-JUNE 6) WAS A SUCCESS. OFFICERS ISSUED 187 TRAFFIC CITATIONS, 44 OF THESE WERE SEATBELT OFFENSES. FROM MY PERSONAL OBSERVATIONS AND REPORTS FROM OFFICERS IN THE FIELD – SEATBELT USAGE APPEARS TO BE VERY HIGH. BOTTOM LINE – IT BECAME DIFFICULT TO LOCATE VIOLATORS, THIS IS A GOOD THING.**
