Chief's Report – June 12, 2006

We have been very busy in the last 30 days and I need to recognize the entire dept. for their commitment.

May 18th – Kidnapping case – The entire dept. was called in which included 8 officers that were off-duty. All the officers responded as soon as they were notified, not only the full-time officers but the non-paid officers as well. I was very proud of the commitment shown, but the most important thing was that the infant was found safe and sound. All this was possible with the help of Texas Ranger Marrie Aldridge and Constables Duffy and Priest. It was a great example of what can be accomplished when everyone works together.

May 28th – Narcotics arrest – Officer Matt Dear and Officer Mark Montgomery responded to a disturbance and located a vehicle leaving the scene. The vehicle was stopped and the resulting investigation netted over 400 grams (approx. 1 lb.) of Narcotics believed to be methamphetamines. Six adults were arrested and we have also turned over a civil seizure case to the D.A. involving a vehicle and some cash.

June 4th - Aggravated Robbery – Officer Matt Dear Responded to an armed robbery at the Lytle Quick Stop (Exxon). He worked on the investigation and when he passed on his information to Officer Daniel Gamez, Gamez had a suspect in mind right away. They were able to link this Robbery to one in January at the Valero (Formerly Diamond Shamrock). Armed with the names of two suspects and vehicle descriptions we were well on our way to clearing the two robberies. The very next day, June 5th, Officer Dear and Sgt. Reyes were both on duty when they heard Poteet P. D. being dispatched to an armed robbery. The dispatcher gave the description of the suspect and the weapon used. Officer Dear radioed Poteet and advised them that the description matched that of our suspect and to be on the look out for a blue Honda with front end damage. Sgt. Reyes was at the office and phoned in the same information to dispatch, when he heard the call. Within just a few seconds Poteet Police stopped the suspects and made two arrests for aggravated robbery. This will lead to clearing up our two armed robberies.

Other P.D. News

Cpl. Santos Ramirez resigned his full-time position and started work for Toyota today. He started working for us in Feb. of 1999. He has been a wonderful and dedicated employee. He will be staying on as a non-paid officer so he will still be around, just not as often. He told me it was a difficult decision because he enjoyed working with us.

With Cpl. Ramirez leaving we will be one officer short. I currently have no non-paid officers interested in the full-time position. Mark Montgomery will be working part time paid and filling in some shifts to help us with the position vacated by Cpl. Ramirez. Other non-paid officers might also help out as needed. While I need the full-time position filled I plan on holding off for a couple months for various reasons.
