

ORDINANCE NO. 457

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYTLE RENAMING EASY STREET TO RUIZ-FOSTER WAY; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LYTLE; REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LYTLE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS: Citizens of the City of Lytle have requested that Easy Street be renamed; and,

WHEREAS: The City of Lytle is a Type A General-Law city organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS: Section 51.001 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the governing body of a municipality to adopt, publish, amend or repeal an ordinance, rule or police regulation that is for the good government, peace or order of the municipality or for the trade and commerce of the municipality and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the municipality or to an office or department of the municipality; and,

WHEREAS: Section 311.002 of the Texas Transportation Code authorizes a municipality to regulate any highways and streets of the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYTLE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. RENAMING STREET. Easy Street is hereby renamed Ruiz-Foster Way.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Any provision in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lytle that conflicts with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and official publication.

SECTION 4. NOTICES. The City Secretary shall send notice of the renaming of the street to the Atascosa County Appraisal District, the Atascosa County 911 addressing agency, the Atascosa County Sheriff's Department, the Atascosa County Elections Administrator, Lytle Independent School District and City Public Service.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision, subdivision, clause or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged or held unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any other part or provision contained herein.
