

ORDINANCE NO. 412

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 11 OF APPENDIX A OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LYTLE PERTAINING TO THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND, PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS: The City of Lytle is a Type A General Law municipality duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Texas; and;

WHEREAS: After due deliberation, the City Council has determined that the location and time for the placement of rubbish and bulky waste for collection needs to be more clearly established; and,

WHEREAS: Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001 authorizes the governing body of any municipality to adopt, publish, amend, or repeal an ordinance, rule or police regulation that is for the good government, peace, or order of the municipality or for the trade and commerce of the municipality and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the municipality or to an office or department of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYTLE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Amendment. Article II, Section 11 of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lytle pertaining to the collection of Solid Waste is hereby amended to add the following Subsections, to-wit:

A. Location of Rubbish for collection:

Customers shall place rubbish for collection at the curbside of the customer's real property. Curbside refers to that portion of the right-of-way adjacent to paved or traveled City roadways. Rubbish shall be placed as close to the roadway as practicable without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians. Rubbish shall not be placed at the curbside earlier than 10 days before the scheduled collection.

B. Location of Bulky Waste for collection:

Customers shall place bulky waste for collection at the curbside of the customer's real property. Curbside refers to that portion of the right-of-way adjacent to paved or traveled City roadways. Bulky waste shall be placed as close to the roadway as practicable without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians. Bulky waste shall not be placed at the curbside earlier than 10 days before the scheduled collection.


SECTION 2. Repeal. Any provision in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lytle, including section headings, that conflicts with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Code of Ordinances. It is the intention of the City Council that this ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lytle and may be renumbered and codified therein accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and official publication as provided by law.


SECTION 5. Severability. If any section, provision, subdivision, clause or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged or held unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any other part or provision contained herein.
