

Minutes of Mobile Home Commission meeting held November 5, 2018

Mobile Home Commission meeting with the following present: Donna Hendrick, Jesse Camarillo, Lynn Anderson, Elisa Grouthes.

Visitors: Josie Campa, Ana Delgadillo, Debra Rodriguez, Miguel Aguilar, Eric Delgadillo.

Mobile Home Commission Chairman Donna Hendrick called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. She announced the purpose of the meeting and asked if there were any pros and cons for this request.

Miguel Aguilar, who has the lot next door expressed concerns due to the age of this mobile home. City Secretary Josie Campa told Mr. Aguilar and the Commission members that due to the age of the home it would have to be inspected by the City's building inspector before it is moved in to the city. She said if the inspector feels it is up to code or can be brought up to code then the home can be moved in. If it cannot be brought up to code, it will not be allowed in. The City Secretary told everyone that if the home is moved in, it will have to be inspected again to make sure code requirements are met.

After discussion, Donna Hendrick made the motion that the Commission recommend to Council that the mobile home request from Ana Delgadillo be granted contingent upon the home being inspected prior to move by inspector and approved for moving. The home is also to be inspected once it is in place to make sure everthing is up to the city's code requirements. Seconded by Lynn Anderson. Passed unanimously.
