

Minutes of Mobile Home Commission Meeting held October 5, 2020

Mobile Home Commission meeting with the following present: Commission members Elisa Grothues, Troy Whitney, Jesse Camarillo, Donna Hendrick.

Visitors: City Secretary Josie Campa, Cheryl Salisbury, Teresa Soto, Edward Soto, George and Bernice Rodriguez, Eva DeLeon.

Commission Chairman Donna Hendrick opened the meeting at 6:34 p.m. and told everyone the purpose for the meeting. She then told the Commission about the two requests. Ms. Hendrick asked the City Secretary if she had heard anything from the people that she sent letters to and whether there are utilities in the area of where Edward and Teresa Soto want to place a mobile home.

City Secretary Josie Campa told the Commission she had not heard from anyone, pro or con. She also told the Commission that utilities are available as there is already a house on the property. The Sotos hope to get permission from Council to keep the old house on their lot until the mobile home is put in place.

Jesse Camarillo made the motion that the Commission recommend to Council that the Sotos be allowed to have the mobile home placed on their property. Seconded by Troy Whitney. Motion passed unanimously.

The Commission discussed the request from Margarito Carrillo for placement of a mobile home on a ½ acre tract of land located at 18062 Wisdom Road. After discussion, Troy Whitney made the motion that the Commission recommend to Council that Mr. Carrillo be allowed to place the mobile home on his property. Seconded by Elisa Grothues. Passed unanimously.
